We are pleased to announce that The Community Foundation of Middle Tennessee, in conjunction with the Tennessee Arts Commission, will again offer the **Arts Build Communities** Grants. This is a matching grant program funded by the Tennessee General Assembly and administered in cooperation with the Tennessee Arts Commission and other designated agencies. The ABC grant benefits art projects undertaken by approved nonprofit organizations, libraries, government agencies and schools providing up to \$3,000 in matching funds.

Organizations in the following counties are encouraged to apply: Bedford, Cannon, Cheatham, Clay, Coffee, Cumberland, DeKalb, Fentress, Franklin, Giles, Hickman, Jackson, Lawrence, Lewis, Lincoln, Macon, Marshall, Maury, Moore, Overton, Perry, Pickett, Putnam, Robertson, Rutherford, Smith, Sumner, Trousdale, Van Buren, Warren, Wayne, White, Williamson, and Wilson.

ABC Grant Application and Guidelines will be accessible through our website www.cfmt.org/grants after July 1. Once there you will click on the link that will redirect you to The Tennessee Arts Commission's website for the application and guidelines. Complete the application online, save it to your computer, and then print and mail it in with all your attachments and original signatures. If you do not have internet access, please visit your local library. Unfortunately, we will be unable to accept any handwritten applications. **Make sure you use the current grant application from the website. Out of date applications will not be accepted.**

The application **deadline is AUGUST 31, 2010 AT 4:30 P.M.** Art Projects should take place between October 15, 2010 and June 15, 2011.

The Community Foundation will conduct three special grant-writing workshops for potential applicants. **PLEASE NOTE: ABC Grant Guidelines and Application are revised yearly by the Tennessee Arts Commission. It is highly recommended that you attend at least one of these workshops to better understand these changes.**
