6 Years of Supporting Early Childhood Educators

The 2024–2025 contract year marked ***six years*** for our team at **ChildcareTennessee**.

This year, we traveled across the state to attend conferences and connect with providers face-to-face. From first-time teachers to Family Home Providers celebrating 20 years in the field, we witnessed the passion and dedication that drive Early Childhood Educators across Tennessee.

Today, half of Americans live in ***“childcare deserts,”*** with only one childcare spot available for every three children. Tennessee is no exception. That’s why our **Establishment Grant** and **Expansion Grant** are so critical—this year alone, they helped create ***8,886 new childcare spots*** across the state. These additional opportunities for children and families will have a lasting impact for years to come.

We also launched our second year of the **Safety Supplemental Grant**, which has empowered providers to strengthen safety and security in their programs. From upgrading camera systems to installing protective film to hiring consultants who train staff in intruder preparedness, providers are finding meaningful ways to stay vigilant—without raising tuition for families.

As we close this grant cycle, we reflect on the castles built, the artwork created, the smiles shared, and the sighs of relief felt. Childhood may not last forever, but we’re proud to know we’ve played a part in making it brighter and safer for many.
