Goal of Scholarship:

- Provide funding for intellectually gifted students who demonstrate financial need so they can pursue academic opportunities that support their future educational and career goals.
- The funding can be applied to academic advancement opportunities, including:
 - Summer or short-term academic programs at institutions of higher learning
 - Qualifying entrance exams for higher education, such as the SAT or ACT
- This scholarship fund is awarded twice during the calendar year. The first timeline is to fund spring academic programs, and the second is to fund summer academic programs.

Application Timeline:

Spring Programming: August 1st - October 15th

Summer Programming: January 1st - March 15th

Award Notification:

Spring Programming: End of November/ beginning of December

Summer Programming: End of April/ beginning of May

Eligibility Requirements:

- Students must be residents of one of the following Tennessee counties:
 - Cannon
 - DeKalb
 - Rutherford
 - Wilson
- Students must be rising 6th-12th graders
- Identified for gifted services within their school system
- Demonstrate financial need

This application is **NOT for graduating seniors looking for college scholarships.*

Documentation Requirement:

- Complete Application
- Student resume outlining student activities, employment, awards, and achievements
- Academic Recommendation
- Personal Recommendation
- School Counselor must upload student transcript, test scores, and eligibility report for gifted services

Financial Amount Awarded:

- Varies per program due to varying costs
- Varies per applicant due to financial circumstances
