The Arthur E. Newman Scholarship Fund FAQs

Goal of Program

- Established to provide financial support for HealthStream's employees in their personal journey to improve their skills and higher education.
- As a reimbursement program, applicants may be reimbursed for some of the costs that have been personally paid by the student during the prior semester or quarter of the school year.

Application Timeline:

- Opens October 1st and closes December 1st annually.

Award Notification:

- Recipients are notified by mid-February.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be full-time employees of HealthStream
- Minimum of one year of service
- Must be enrolled in an accredited junior college, college/university
- Must have a minimum of 3.0 GPA during the academic period for which reimbursement is sought

Documentation Requirements:

- Complete application
- Transcript
- Employment status
- College/University cost of attendance
- Copies of payment receipts
 - You may need to create one document that includes copies of all receipts.
 - Please make sure the receipts show proof of your payment(s) - meaning the form of payment must be visible. If you have questions, please reach out to the Scholarship Team for clarity.

*****All of these items must be submitted by the deadline in order for your application to be considered complete. *****

Amount Awarded

- Award amounts vary based on the number of applicants and available funds
- Recent award amounts have ranged from \$500 - \$1,000.
