Goal of Scholarship

-Established to provide financial support for the children of Tractor Supply employees who are pursuing higher education.

Application Timeline:

- Opens December 1st – Closes February 1st

Award Notification:

- Recipients are notified by April 15th via the email they applied with

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be graduating high school seniors, college freshmen, sophomores, and juniors who are dependent children of full-time or part-time employees of Tractor Supply Company
- Employees must have a minimum of 1 year of service with Tractor Supply Company for their dependent to be eligible
- ****This scholarship is only for dependents of Tractor Supply Company employees. ****

Documentation Requirements:

- Complete application
- Transcript
 - If you are a current high school senior, your counselor will need to upload this via a unique link in the application
- Academic recommendation
 - If you have been out of school for some time, we still need an academic recommendation. Please consider asking someone who can speak to your academic potential.
- Personal recommendation

****All of these items must be submitted by the deadline in order for your application to be considered complete****

How do I go about getting my recommendations submitted?

- Both the Academic and Personal Recommendations must be completed via a unique link you will send to your recommender when completing the application
- The recommender will complete a survey and have the option to submit a narrative for the student; therefore, no printed letter is needed.
- Your recommender must submit the recommendations by the application deadline for your application to be considered.

Financial Amount Awarded

- Award amounts vary based on the number of applicants and available funds
- Recent award amounts have ranged between \$1,000 - \$2,000
- Scholarships do not need to be repaid

Payment Process

- Scholarship payments are made directly to the educational institution and issued before the start of the fall semester. Payment is split between the fall and spring semesters. For recipients graduating in December, the full amount will be applied in the spring semester.
