Application Components

 - You should include the unopened envelopes with your completed application. Do not send separately.
- Completed Financial Aid Questionnaire
- An attached brochure or information sheet detailing the personal development coursework you plan to take.

Timeline

- Please submit your application at least six (6) weeks prior to the beginning of the course.
- We review applications as we receive them. If all application components are completed when we receive the application, it takes 2-3 weeks to review and make a decision.
